

Based on the government’s advice and guidelines, the studio has added some additional protocols so we can all continue to operate and ensure everyone feels safe, including:

- Reduced studio capacity (lowering the maximum number of students that can enroll in each class)
- Increased sanitizing of communal areas surfaces such as door handles, toilet, sink areas, etc.
- Sanitizing of all studio floors after classes each night
- Staggered entry for high traffic class times
- Use of hand sanitizer upon arrival, and regularly throughout your time with us. **Ideally bring your own to reduce contact with our dispensers.**
- The lobby seating area is only to be used for staggered entry and as an exit buffer to minimize proximity with people. If there are more than 2 people in the lobby please wait outside at an appropriate distance.
- Arrive at your allocated time and not before. Early arrivals will be required to wait outside. No early drop-offs are allowed. If students arrive early, they are asked to wait in the car or outside.
- Only enrolled students & staff will be allowed inside the studio. Parents please drop off and pick up only.

BAY AREA DANCE MOVES STUDIO PROTOCOL	
EMPLOYEE GUIDELINES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Upon entry, staff will conduct a health assessment, including temperature checks.</li> <li>• Staff will wash/sanitize hands prior to class and at regular intervals.</li> <li>• Staff will work to limit direct physical contact with children.</li> <li>• Staff will wear face coverings in the studio during classes and in all common areas of the studio</li> <li>• Staff will be assigned to sanitize all high contact areas along with barres/doorknobs/etc. between classes.</li> </ul>
PARENT GUIDELINES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Dancers may not enter the facility if they are exhibiting any symptoms or have been exposed to Covid-19.</b></li> <li>• Parents must conduct their own health assessment of their dancer prior to arriving at the studio <u>each day</u>. <b>See QR code or assessment on the studio website</b></li> <li>• Staff reserves the right to administer no-contact temperature checks as warranted. Any dancer with a temperature that exceeds 100.4F will be sent home.</li> <li>• All families must sign an updated waiver at the time of registration which includes information on Covid-19, along with updated general policies for the 2020-2021 dance season.</li> </ul>
BUILDING POLICIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recommended cleaning/disinfectant products that are effective against Covid-19 will be used throughout each day.</li> <li>• Door handles will be wiped and cleaned after uses.</li> <li>• Hand Sanitizer will be available throughout the building.</li> <li>• Dancers are encouraged to bring their own personal water bottle from home.</li> <li>• Please no late pick-ups.</li> <li>• No snacks/eating while in the dance rooms.</li> <li>• We are currently unable to store any lost &amp; found items. Any items left will be discarded daily.</li> </ul>
ENTRY TO/FROM THE BUILDING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dancers should arrive at the studio in dance attire, bringing any dance shoes needed for the day.</li> <li>• We encourage all dancers to use the restroom facilities &amp; wash their hands before leaving home.</li> <li>• Dancers will be allowed to enter the building at their assigned time &amp; will be directed to their assigned classroom.</li> <li>• Everyone will be required to sanitize/wash hands upon entering the studio.</li> <li>• Masks are required for all parents entering the building.</li> <li>• Masks are required by all dancers (10+) in common areas of the studio (lobby, hallways, bathrooms, etc) <i>and highly encouraged for dancers under age 10.</i></li> <li>• Dancers will be encouraged to sanitize after class.</li> </ul>
DURING PRACTICE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All belongings should be labeled with dancer's name.</li> <li>• Once inside the classroom dancers will be instructed to stand six feet apart, there will be visible markings on the floor.</li> <li>• Please be aware every effort to adhere to this policy will be made in classrooms with our youngest dancers but the possibility of improper social distancing at times will exist.</li> <li>• Bathroom breaks are limited to one student at a time.</li> </ul>

**We are requesting that everyone at the studio work diligently to provide up-to-date and truthful information in regards to the themselves and their dancers at all times. Our ability to offer classes through the dance studio is fully dependent on everyone doing their part to help keep our kids, our families and our staff healthy.**

Please note that we have the right to refuse entry to anyone attending the studios if you have COVID-19 symptoms, and no refunds will be eligible.

Bay Area Dance Moves reserves the right to modify the policies listed above. In the event of a mandatory studio closure, classes will be conducted virtually. No refunds or credit will be given.
